### Introduction

The award is for *an individual or a group of individuals* to recognize extraordinary *achievements*. The award is also made to *encourage* the profession and the industry to aim for excellence and to reach out and create interest among learners, parents, teachers and students.

A better quality of life for all communities forms the basis of the philosophy, measured against the background of Sustainable Engineering as a pre-requisite for Sustainable Development.

### Rules

1. Entries must comply with the **SMART AWARD** philosophy as illustrated below:

2. Entries must demonstrate sustainability and environmental care, construct-ability or implement-ability
3. Entries must demonstrate contribution to the social environment including for example community development and career guidance potential
4. Entries can suggest concepts to be developed further or provide a comprehensive solution
5. Entries must comply with the following requirements:
  - An executive summary no more than 300 words must be submitted
  - A comprehensive description of not more than 1000 words must be submitted
  - Sketches, photographs and diagrams must be submitted
  - Concepts will remain the intellectual property of the person who enters the concept
  - SAICE, SANRAL and SANLAM retain the right to publicize and communicate the entries as it chooses subject to the conditions that the origin and source would be reconfirmed
  - SAICE, SANRAL and SANLAM retain the right to appoint adjudicators and will not enter into discussion regarding the decision of the judges.
  - If an entry is submitted by a third party, the original source must be identified
6. The *organisers* will prepare a presentation of selected submissions for the SAICE Awards function
